## Contrast


If two items are not exactly the same, then make them really different.



### Do this

Add contrast through typeface, font, weight, color, shape, size, space, etc.


Everything has an opposite. Pick something that would have the most impact and USE CONTRAST.



### Don't do this

Make something slightly different and call it contrast.







### STUDENT ENROLLMENT GROWTH




Repeat some aspects of the design throughout the entire piece.

Add elements whose sole purpose is repetition.




### Don't do this


Repeat a visual element so much that it becomes annoying or overwhelming.

Try to repeat too many elements on a single page design.

















# Alignment


Every item should have a visual alignment with something else on the page.





### Do this

Always find something else on the page to align with, even if the two objects are far away from one another.



### Don't do this

Use every different text alignment (right, left, center) on the same page.

Use center alignment as a default.



# Proximity


Group related items together. Physical closeness implies a relationship.



### Do this

Create 3-5 visual elements on a single page.


Use white space to separate visual elements.



### Don't do this

Create relationships with elements that don't belong together.

Add extra elements just because the space is empty.




