This video captures the excitement and educational impact of Spring ISD's official solar eclipse event on April 8, 2024. With the rare astronomical phenomenon passing near the Houston area, students and teachers across the district seized the opportunity to engage in hands-on learning. Leading up to the event, science lessons and classroom activities helped students prepare, culminating in campus-wide eclipse viewing celebrations-highlighted by the district's official event at Beneke Elementary School.
