When Say Paw came to Louisville as a first grader, she didnt speak English. Shes now a JCPS teacher. What Say Paw didnt know until a reunion this year is that she was the inspiration for a former elementary school teacher to learn new languages and teach multilingual students. The video was shared on all of our social media platforms, website, and through our newsletters. We have a growing multilingual learner population (21,000+ students) and this story is a way to relate to those students and families. It shows how while it might be overwhelming at first to come to a new country and learn a new language, it can be done and you can help inspire others.
