As a communication tool, this video effectively engaged stakeholders by making them feel like part of the celebration. Instead of simply announcing the finalists in a press release or social media post, we used video to tell the story in an emotional and authentic way. Seeing the finalists' reactions and the joy of their students and colleagues made the announcement far more impactful. The video also reinforced the districts commitment to elevating and enhancing the Teacher of the Year program, ensuring that the recognition extended beyond a single event and into the broader community. The video successfully generated excitement and positive engagement across social media. It was widely shared, with students, parents, and fellow educators commenting their congratulations and expressing pride in the honorees. The communitys enthusiastic response demonstrated that recognizing educators in this way fosters a culture of appreciation and support. Additionally, the excitement from the surprise visits carried over to the

Teacher of the Year celebration event, creating a sense of anticipation and energy leading up to the final announcement. By sharing this moment, Newton County Schools not only celebrated three outstanding teachers but also reinforced the importance of teacher recognition. The video served as an uplifting reminder of the incredible educators shaping the district and helped to further establish the Teacher of the Year program as a momentous occasion within the community.
