The West40 communications team was inspired by the fact that we are doing good work with our student programs and we wanted our stakeholders and other Regional Offices of Education and Intermediate Service Centers across the state see how the West40 ALOP model helps at-risk students. ALOP stands for Alternative Learning Opportunities Program. It is designed to increase school completion rates/graduation rates for students who are struggling by removing barriers and giving them the support they need. Along with academic and attendance support, our advocates build relationships with our students by infusing social-emotional learning and behavioral support into their days and fostering positive engagement. In addition, our goal with this infographic was to help influence other Regional Offices of Education and Intermediate Service Centers in creating their own student support programs. We designed this infographic to make the information easy to see and understand. The infographic was included in West40's August 2024 digital newsletter, which was sent to more than 3,000 of our stakeholders.
