A Kammerer Middle School sixth grader is lucky to be alive thanks to the quick actions of four staff members at his school. The JCPS staff had training in CPR and knew how to use an AED to shock their student back to life. This story allowed us to bring awareness to the trainings our staff receive as well as the fact that the District invested millions of dollars in installing AEDs in every JCPS building. This story was picked up by all of our local media outlets, even gaining national attention. We shared this on all of our social platforms, our website, newsletters, and at a Board meeting where we recognized the staff.
