

This is a video featuring one of our district's high school career pathways - the Medical and Allied Sciences Pathway at Alfred Ely Beach High School. In this program, students not only learn the science of medicine, but they also get to practice it. As a result of this program, the high school was able to open a community clinic and students themselves work as phlebotomists - under the supervision of medical personnel provided by one of our local hospitals/community partners. By the time they graduate, these students will have a certification as a phlebotomist that will allow them to go directly into the work force or continue their education post-secondary with a solid foundation to start them off. It is a win-win for both the students and the community surrounding the school that now has access to a health clinic.
