The videos also support the districts broader communication strategy by aligning with its commitment to student success and career-connected learning. Outcomes Since launching the TSD Pathways series, the district has seen increased interest in CTE programs, with more students enrolling in career-focused courses. Families report a greater understanding of the benefits of hands-on learning, and administrators have a stronger foundation for advocating continued investment in these programs.
