The target audience also includes families who are exploring educational options for their children, as well as local community members who are interested in learning about the opportunities and benefits of vocational education. Additionally, educators and school administrators are part of the target audience, so they can gain insights into how Dean Tech fosters student success through supportive relationships and hands-on learning experiences. The target audience also includes our community partners and area businesses that provide co-op learning opportunities for Dean students and often employ them after graduation.
