The Pat Jackson Seminar Scholarship is administered by the NSPRA Foundation for the Advancement of Education and was created to honor Pat’s legacy and continue his efforts to improve the practice of public relations in education. The scholarship provides one registration to the annual NSPRA Seminar for a deserving NSPRA member.

- Must be employed in a full-time professional school public relations/communications position.
- Have not yet registered for the 2019 National Seminar (*a current registration cannot be replaced by a scholarship*).

## **Applications**

Applicants must follow the guidelines as directed and submit the requested information no later than February 1, 2019. (See application form).

## **Selection**

A sub-committee of the NSPRA Executive Board will review the applications and recommend a candidate to the full Board for approval at the March 2019 board meeting. The candidate will be notified at that time.

**Please Note:** Following the Seminar, the successful candidate will be asked to write a column for an NSPRA publication describing the professional benefits of his or her Seminar experience.
