



# 2019 NSPRA Seminar Don Bagin Memorial Scholarship Application

**July 14-17, 2019 – Washington, D.C.**

The Don Bagin Memorial Scholarship is administered by the NSPRA Foundation for the Advancement of Education and was made possible by the generous donations of NSPRA members in his memory. The scholarship provides one registration to the NSPRA National Seminar.

Don Bagin, Ed.D, was not only one of NSPRA's iconic leaders, he was one of the truly influential leaders in the field of public relations for over 40 years. He served as NSPRA President in 1981-82 and received the NSPRA Presidents Award in 1986. As a professor at Rowan University in New Jersey since the 1960's, Don taught more than 2,000 students over the course of his career. He helped to create the university's first public relations program and then launched its graduate program in school public relations, the first of its kind in the country. He continued to coordinate the graduate programs in educational and corporate public relations throughout his tenure.

A prolific author, he co-wrote the school PR textbook *The School & Community Relations* which is used in universities across the nation and has been translated into several languages. He also founded *Communications Briefings*, an international communications newsletter. A frequent and popular presenter at NSPRA Seminars for many years, Don was one of the biggest advocates and promoters of the school public relations profession, mentoring and encouraging promising young practitioners and NSPRA members throughout his career.
