Seminar Scholarship Application
July 14-17, 2019 – Washington, D.C.

Each year, the NSPRA Foundation for the Advancement of Education offers two scholarships to NSPRA's National Seminar. These scholarships are awarded to individuals who are new to school public relations and are intended to expand their knowledge of the profession and expose them to the benefits of NSPRA membership. Each scholarship includes the waiver of the Seminar registration fee and a \$250 stipend for expenses. One of these scholarships is specifically designated for a school public relations professional who is an ethnic minority.

Eligibility

Eligible candidates:

- Have worked in school public relations less than three years.
- Have *never* attended an NSPRA Seminar.
- Are employed in a full-time professional school public relations position.
- Are chapter members in good standing (*NSPRA membership is not required to qualify*).
- Have not yet registered for the 2019 National Seminar (*a current registration cannot be replaced by a scholarship.*)

Qualifications are the same for the designated ethnic minority scholarship.

Applications

Applicants must follow the guidelines as directed and submit the requested information no later than February 1, 2019. (See application form).

Selection

A sub-committee of the NSPRA Executive Board will review the applications and recommend two candidates to the full Board for approval at the March 2019 board meeting. The candidates will be notified at that time.
